

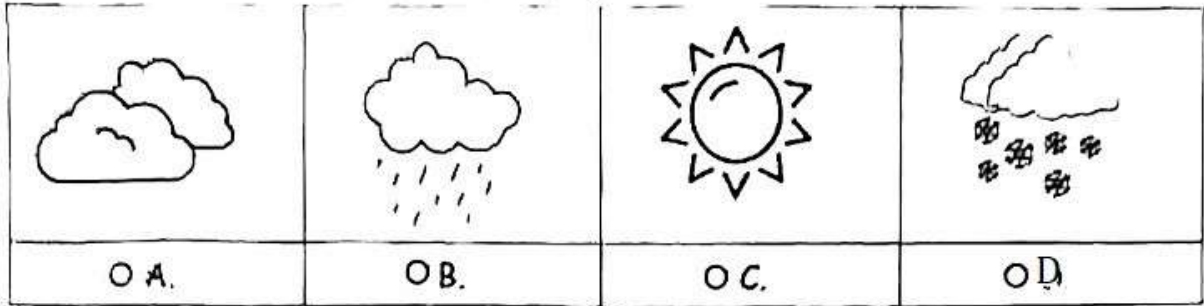
Rainy

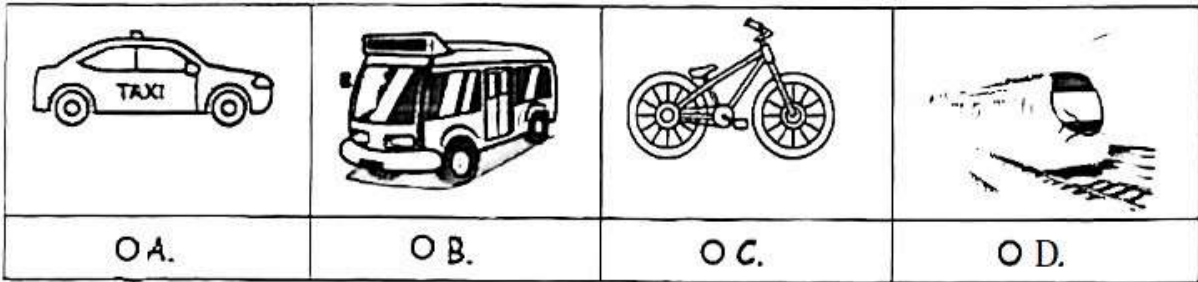

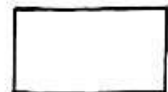

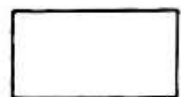
